From News paper reports we gather that once a popular idea/generally accepted solution is submitted to the Govt. it should be left over it to form a policy/plan/ordinance/Act on that with the consultation and acceptance of all the parties and interests involved. The Women's Reservation Bill or Lokpal Bill are such examples. But the Govt. Finds it difficult to develop consensus on what public wishes or what is in the interest of general public.

The conclusion which public derive is that within the present system, formation of a new authority/legislation to control or improve functioning of Govt. is quite difficult. But all has not been lost.

Your and Annaji's all efforts are laudable. We are ready to provided support of any kind. I am an active member of Pitampura Group discussion panel.

However with continuous efforts for last two years our society has developed a paper on "Taxation and civic system reforms in India" which are enclosed herewith for you and your team member's kind perusal. The reformations are in sync with Annaji's declaration at Ram lila Maidan that there should be decentralization of power and provide way how it can be done in our country.

The Civic services Act as envisaged is such that on formulation ,on one hand it will stop generation of black money and thus will wipe off the main means of corruption ,and on the other it might attract least opposition as beside public it is also in the interest and for the benefit of Govt. machinery & political leaders.

The Hindi version in PDF is also enclosed. We hope you will appreciate the efforts and will forward it for discussion and policy formation to appropriate panel/Annaji, others at the earliest.

But on one point I differ. Your many moves/steps have touched only the literates. Here I feel we are lacking. I am developing a pamphlet presenting new tax model in simple most and shortest language. Secondly I am trying to write a play in Jhuggiwallas/slum people language showing what they will get by new system. This can be staged by Nukkar or other team in every corner of our country among them under a plan. You may also plan in that way. Pl. guide me in the matter. This model has already been sent to present govt. as per enclosed sheet. A RTI on that can also be planned. For any clarification we can meet on 10/11-3-2012
