

SEE HOW THE POOR PEOPLE ARE NEGLECTED IN INDIA

TOI news dt. July 4,2015 based on Socio economic caste census

(SECC) report released on July 3,2015

- The last caste census was taken way back in 1932 and discontinued since.
- Census 2011 ignored the SECC features showing poverty figures of India and condition of poor living here .
- After independence there was utter need to keep continuing the socio economic census (SEC) eliminating the disputed caste factor.
- But no ,Government of India gave priority to concrete structure & infra structure development forgetting all along the requirements for uplifting the standard of deprived people of India.
- A need to keep a vigilance check over educational progress of every village was ignored (even present poor standards of education & educational facilities in villages and in urba areas also are a witness to that) and the result is-
Out of total rural households of about 18 crores . 50% are deprived on one or more counts,
30% are landless families with major income from manual labour,
Families with no one over 25 literate are 23.5 % and
92% rural homes run on less than 10,000/- per month. 75% reported that income of highest earning member is 5,000/- or less.
- Nothing better will come out from survey of urban India (done seriously or not- report is still pending or may never see the light) , many rural people being migrated to urban areas with same poor standard except that many in order to become rich early have engulfed in crimes of many kind. The income of still many families will be 15,000/-or less with income of highest earning member will be 8000/- or less. And thus about 75% of urban households may come out as deprived on one or more counts.

HOWEVER ALL IS NOT LOST .

GOVERNMENT CAN DIRECT STATE GOVERNMENTS TO FORM A VIGILENCE AGENCY (posting four IAS cadre

officers of same region & residing there itself) IN EACH VILLAGE & TOWN to KEEP VIGILE ON EDUCATIONAL STANDARDS OF EACH FAMILY LIVING IN THEIR AREA. AND TO REPORT PROGRESS ON EDUCATIONAL PARAMETERS TO **PMO** DIRECTLY FOR TAKING APPROPRIATE DECISIONS AND ACTIONS BY CENTRE OFFICIALS.

BUT FOR THAT GOVERNMENT WILL HAVE TO CUT ATTENTION AND FUNDS FROM EXTRAVAGANT & GLAMOROUS EXPENDITURES e.g
